The summaries are deliberately presented in precise and concise formats for rapid digest of Governor Okowa's scorecard.

The fact sheets constitute an ongoing series that will be updated with verified statistical data and evidence-based information, on a regular basis.

This Fact Sheet No. 1 focuses on the direct and indirect jobs created under the various job creation, youth empowerment and social investment platforms established by His Excellency, the Governor, from 2015 to date.

The following table gives detailed account of direct & indirect jobs created among Deltan youths, micro and small enterprises through the various job creation, youth empowerment, enterprise microcredit and grant programmes.

1. Overall, 128,813 direct and indirect jobs have been created through the various job creation, youth empowerment and social investments delivery platforms established by His Excellency, the Governor, from 2015 to date.
2. Delta State unemployment rate is lower at 31% compared to the national all-states average of 37%, based on survey by National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) published in 2021.
3. Delta State became the 2nd least poor state in 2020, much improvement from 12th Least Poor State in 2010, based on the most recent national survey by National Bureau of Statistics (NBS).
